

### Rules

- 1. Entries in all classes: Points to count per vase, 3 for 1st, 2 for 2nd, 1 for 3<sup>rd</sup>, 3 for Champion Bloom, 3 for Section Champion, 1 for Best Exhibit Awards. Any Number of Entries in each class, but one to count for Points.
- 2. No Awards will be made unless entry is of sufficient merit. Judges decision will be Final.
- 3. All Exhibits to be Staged by 11 am and then Hall cleared for Judging.
- 4. All Exhibits must be grown by Exhibitor.
- 5. Where Possible entries to be named Gladiolus and Dahlias.
- Sizes as in classified lists. Gladiolus; small 1mm 200mm, Medium 300mm, Large 400mm. Dahlias; Giant 250mm+, Large 200mm - 250mm, Medium 150mm 200mm, Small 115mm - 155mm, Miniature under 115mm, Pompom under 50mm.
- 7. Only Gladioli Foliage to be used in staging Gladiolus, and no artificial aids allowed.
- All informals to be staged in one vase.
- Colours are with or without markings.
- 10. Use Societies containers.
- 11. The Committee reserve the right to grade any Exhibitor.
- 12. Hall open for staging: SATURDAY AM TO 11AM
- 13. Entries on the Day
